

Results already achieved

SmartPilots Interreg Europe

1 Policy change:



Operational Program 'investment in growth and jobs' Flanders 2014-2020

LP Bio Base Europe Pilot Plant + PP2 Department of Economy, Science and Innovation – Flemish Government

Study conducted through the project confirmed the status and relevance of BBEPP as a key innovation facility in Flanders, and established its status of research organisation eligible for VLAIO grants (Flanders agency for Innovation & Entrepreneurship).

Successful application to 2 projects: IMPACT and BioBaseFlow with a total **of 5,2 millions EUR influenced.**

What about the future?

- May 2018: Interreg Europe not present in the EC draft proposal for 2021-2027: pan European interregional cooperation no longer possible!
- Since then: negotiation with EP and Council who asked for Interreg Europe to be back
- To be continued.... (finalisation of regulation, budget decision)
